



## **SOUTH CAROLINA HALL OF FAME** **Nominee Requirements &** **Nomination Form**

The South Carolina Hall of Fame, dedicated on February 11, 1973, by Governor John C. West, was created to recognize and honor those contemporary and past citizens who have made outstanding contributions to South Carolina's heritage and progress. It is a nonprofit corporation conducted under a state charter. The South Carolina Hall of Fame is located in the Myrtle Beach Convention Center, Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. On September 21, 2001, Governor Jim Hodges signed into law a bill designating the South Carolina Hall of Fame as the state's official hall of fame.

Persons born in South Carolina who obtained recognition elsewhere and persons born elsewhere but who made their home in and obtained esteem and recognition in the state of South Carolina are eligible for induction. The Confederation of South Carolina Local Historical Societies is the official organization for selecting nominees for the Hall of Fame. The Confederation meets in the summer of each year to select 10 contemporary and 10 deceased nominees whom it presents to the Board of Trustees for judging in late fall. One contemporary and one deceased citizen may be inducted into the Hall of Fame annually.

The Nomination Form should not exceed three (3) pages, total. Additional supporting documentation is strongly recommended and may include, but is not limited to, proof of residency; specific records (newspaper articles, letters, encyclopedia listings, etc.) relating to the nominee's background – professional, military, historical, religious, political, etc.; achievements; honors, commendations and awards; professional affiliations, publications; civic or community involvement; personal accomplishments; positive impact on the community and/or citizenry of South Carolina.
